MISSION:



ACADEMIC YEAR AND CURRICULUM

- ✓ The school Academic year is from April to March.
- ✓ The school follows the new examination pattern given by the CBSE for the current Academic year 2022 - 2023.
- ✓ 100% of the syllabus will be covered.

FEE PAYMENT

The school fee Payment for the Academic year is divided into

I Term on or before 15th of June
II Term on or before 15th of October
III Term on or before 15th of February

PROMOTION RULES

- ✓ Promotion to the higher class is not automatic. The marks obtained in the Annual examination will be the deciding factor in determining the promotion along with the 80% attendance.
- ✓ Parents will receive periodic reports from the Principal regarding the student's performance. Parents should respond by meeting the Principal, if called. Such meetings will ensure the students fully benefit from the measures taken for their improvement. Since such meetings have bearing on the future prospects of the students & parents are instructed to co-operate.

Examinations

- ✓ Subject Enrichment Activity (For Grade 10 & 12), Periodic Tests/Mid – Term Tests and Terminal Examinations will be conducted for the academic year 2022-23.
- ✓ Any student caught using unfair means during examination is liable to be summarily removed from the rolls and a transfer certificate will be issued.
- ✓ Every child should learn about two hours in the evening and one hour in the mornings during school days and longer hours during holidays to face the examinations with confidence.
- ✓ The school does not guarantee the success of pupils' studies unless the parents/guardians cooperate with the school authority and do their part by enforcing regularity and discipline.

WITHDRAWALS

- ✓ Transfer certificate will be issued only on receipt of a written application from the parent of the pupil.
- ✓ If a student wishes to withdraw at the end of the academic year, an application for the Transfer Certificate should be submitted on or before 15th of March. If he/she fails to do so, first term fees will be collected. This is applicable even to the students who leave the school in the middle of the year.
- ✓ The management has the right to ask a parent to withdraw his/her ward from the school without assigning any reason, if it considers that the students conduct or influence is detrimental to the school.
- ✓ After paying all the dues of the school the Transfer Certificate will be issued after the announcement of result.
- ✓ T.C. should be collected only by their father/mother who has signed in the admission form.



Rules and Regulations

- * Students will report to school only after 9.00 a.m. and parents should take the students before 4.30 p.m. The school authorities are not responsible for the student's safety after the specified time.
- * The handbook must be brought to school every day and the ID cards should be worn regularly to school.
- * Attendance is compulsory on the first and last working day of each semester/Academic year.
- * Meeting the teachers during the class hours is strictly prohibited.
- * No one should be absent by himself/herself without prior information except under unforeseen circumstances.
- * In such cases, the reason for taking leave shall be informed to the school office before 9.30 a.m.
- * If a student who is absent more than three days on account of illness, must produce medical certificate.
- * The students should not be sent to school if they have any infectious diseases like Flu, Mumps, Infective Hepatitis, Severe cold, typhoid etc.,
- * Taking leave on Sports day / Independence Day will be very seriously viewed. Parents are advised not to plan for any outings, functions, pilgrims etc., during these days.
- * If any holiday is declared by the Government of Tamilnadu due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, please follow the instructions given in TV/Newspaper and the school's circular.
- * Partial attendance to school on any day is not allowed. That is, students cannot attend school only for a part of the day; they can take leave with prior permission. Permission in between the class hours will not be entertained.
- * Check the handbook daily for homework, special notices or circulars and remarks made in the handbook should be seen and countersigned regularly.
- * Homework assigned to the pupil should be done regularly taking down the work assigned in their handbook. The same will be intimated through Uolo App.
- * Check their note books, school diaries, report cards regularly and take adequate measures for the progress of their children.
- * Children are expected to keep their text books and note books neatly covered and take care of their belongings.
- * Every student is expected to take part in all co-curricular activities and games unless declared medically unfit or exempted by the Principal for valid reasons.
- * Encourage your child to participate in all the activities of the school and respond to the invitation for all the school functions.
- * Any communications, report or complaint of the parents/guardians, should be addressed to the Principal. They should not deal with the teachers directly regarding any complaint.
- * Any attestation, fees certificate, bonafide certificate (if needed from school office) will be issued only after three days from the date of submission of the application.
- * Children, who indulge in copying, help others in copying and resort to other malpractices related to copying or forgery etc., will be issued TC at once.
- * Students damaging/defacing school property will be fined.
- * Students are not allowed to bring / wear any valuable item to school. The school will not take any responsibility for the loss of the same.
- * Attend the Parent - Teacher meeting regularly.

Instruction to the students

- ✓ **Speaking in English is enforced within the school premises strictly.**
- ✓ Students can donate story books to the library on their birthdays.
- ✓ Personal hygiene should be maintained.
- ✓ Monthly haircut and daily clean shave has to be done by the boys.
- ✓ Shirt buttons should not be kept open and the shirt to be tucked-in properly, irrespective i.e., uniform or Ununiform. Belts should be worn tightly and visibly.
- ✓ Girls should tie their hair two plaits with black bands.
- ✓ No pony tail and loose hairs are allowed inside the school campus.
- ✓ Students are advised to take their breakfast before coming to school. Students should bring a cup of juice to drink during the break period. Must include fruits, vegetables, pulses, greens, milk and dry fruits in their diet.
- ✓ The instructed vegetable must be followed on "VEGETABLE DAY"
- ✓ The class leaders shall maintain silence in the class till the respective teachers come to their class.
- ✓ Pupil moving from one class to another shall be in order, keeping to the left always and shall observe perfect silence on their way.
- ✓ Once a teacher entering into the classroom the pupils shall rise and remain standing till they are instructed to sit. At the end of the class, when the teacher leaves the pupils shall rise again, pay gratitude and resume their seats quickly.
- ✓ The pupils are expected to cooperate in keeping the premises neat and tidy and therefore refrain from scribbling on the wall and lit bits of paper.
