


"Places Of Eminence"

insightful activity to explore the Indian National Movement by studying and pasting historical stamps. This hands-on project provided a tangible connection to key


figures and events in India's history.



The affectionate students of grade 8 had an opportunity to create a heartfelt greeting card for their mothers.


























"Treasures From Past"

"Explore the wild side of life!" The Grade 8 adventurers, delved into the through an engaging and creative project: "designing a zoo advertisement".














"Owls in the Family"

The explorers of grade 7 students have explored the fascinating evolution of localities over time, focusing on market places, villages, and towns.














The active learners of grade 4 engaged in practical learning activities to explore the diverse types of family structures.



CBSE Activities - "Exploring, Learning, Growing Together"

(SAFAL), A Competency - Based Assessment Education Policy 2020 recommends that all students take school examinations in Grades 3, 5, and 8 to assess basic learning outcomes and higher order skills. CBSE has launched Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning (SAFAL), a competency-based assessment for these grades. SAFAL provides developmental feedback to schools and teachers to improve teaching-learning without additional examination pressure. The first mock exam for Grade 5 and Grade 8 was conducted in June 2024, followed by the main exam from July 22nd to August 12th, 2024.
